Attention of All the Importers, Exporters, Customs Brokers, Shipping Lines / Agents, Custodians / Customs Cargo Service Providers, Port Terminal Operators, General Trade / Trade Associations / Chamber of Commerce and all other stakeholders & the Public coming under the jurisdiction of Customs Commissionerate (Preventive), Vijayawada, is invited to the above mentioned subject.

- 2. In terms of the Customs Brokers Licensing Regulations, 2018, applications are invited, in the prescribed format of FORM-A available in CBLR 2018 for conducting ONLINE WRITTEN EXAMINATION of Customs Brokers Examination 2021, as per the letter File. No. NACIN/Sys/Misc/22/2021-EXAM-O/o Pr DG-NACIN-FARIDABAD issued by the National Academy of Customs, Indirect Taxes & Narcotics (NACIN), Faridabad.
- As per the Notice of the National Academy of Customs, Indirect Taxes & Narcotics (NACIN), Faridabad, an Online Examination is scheduled to be conducted in the month of March, 2022 at the designated examination centers across India. The online written examination will be of three hours duration. Questions will be bilingual i.e., in English and Hindi.
- Applications are invited from Indian citizens to appear in the online written examination for issuance of license to act as a Customs Broker under Customs Brokers Licensing Regulations (CBLR), 2018, as amended. A copy of the regulations is available at www.cbic.gov.in and www.nacin.gov.in.
- Complete application is to be submitted in person or by Registered/ Speed Post 5. in Form-A (available in the CBLR, 2018) along with two passport size photos and self attested documents on citizenship (Aadhaar/ Passport/ Voter Card), educational qualification, financial viability, mobile number, e-mail id and other requirements along with Bank Receipted GAR-7 Challan evidencing payment of prescribed fee of Rs.500/-(Rupees Five Hundred Only) to the Principal Commissioner of Customs (Preventive),

55-17-3, C-14, 2nd Floor, Road No.2, Industrial Estate, Autonagar, Vijayawada-520 007, having jurisdiction over the state of Andhra Pradesh except the Municipal limits of Greater Visakhapatnam Municipal Corporation, between 18.10.2021 to 18.11.2021 up to 06.00 PM.

- 6. Syllabus of written examination will be as per regulation 6(7) of CBLR, 2018.
- Names of the applicants found eligible to appear in examination will be displayed 7. on the notice board and / or website of this Commissionerate latest by 29.11.2021.
- Information regarding roll number, admit card and examination venue will be 8. made available on the website of CBIC and NACIN under the icon/tab <GSTP/CBLR Exam>. A link to download the admit card will also be provided therein. Admit cards shall also be sent by email to eligible applicants 15 days in advance before the date of examination. The date and time of written examination shall be on in the month of March,2022.
- The candidates have the option to answer either in Hindi or in English. 9.
- Successful candidates will be called for an oral examination for which separate 10. communication will be sent.
- In case declarations and information submitted by the applicant are found to be 11. incorrect, the application shall be rejected or license, (if issued) shall be cancelled.
